Babies of mothers who have benefited from the Dispensary's services will be among the participants. The Dispensary annually helps nearly 1,200 women in precarious socioeconomic situations in Greater Montreal to nourish themselves adequately during pregnancy and give birth to healthy babies. It is estimated that 10% of babies from families living in poverty are born with a low weight, less than 2500 g. The interventions carried out at the Dispensary can reduce this rate in half: a good start in life for our babies.
